ANNOUNCES ITS ANNUAL "JOURNEY TO GREECE"  
EDUCATIONAL CAMPAIGN, 2008**

The Order of AHEPA, Las Vegas Chapter #314, is currently accepting applications from qualified students for its annual educational campaign. For 2008, we are awarding students the opportunity to participate in the **"AHEPA JOURNEY TO GREECE, WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF INDIANAPOLIS, ATHENS CAMPUS"**.

**What is the Journey to Greece, 2008 program?**

It is a one month summer study program at the fully accredited University of Indianapolis, Athens campus for students to learn about modern and ancient Greece, to see and experience the beauty of the country and its people, and to **Earn Six Transferable University Credits**.

**When does it take place?**

The Journey to Greece program will be for a duration of one month, starting on July 1st and ending on July 26th, 2008.

**What are the courses?**

The Journey is a study tour and students choose two out of five courses:

- Modern Greek Language 1, (Beginner conversational and written Greek)
- Modern Greek Language 2, (Intermediate conversational and written Greek)
- History of the Greeks of America
- Greek Art and Archaeology
- Plato and Aristotle

Classes meet five days a week, and are fast paced with 20 days of class.

**What about the accommodations?**

Students are housed in University provided apartments. Lunch is provided every weekday and all meals are provided on the excursions, while students make their own arrangements for breakfast and dinner.

**What about the excursion?**

Students will cruise the Aegean for 8 days with EasyCruise lines on the cruise ship "EasyCruise Life". You will visit six different Greek islands, from the lively and cosmopolitan to the laid back and authentic. From the lively islands of Mykonos and Paros to the more authentic Syros and Samos, plus Turkey's number one resort Bodrum.

**What does it cost?**

The tuition of \$2,295 will be paid by Las Vegas Chapter # 314. The student is required to pay for all other costs, including airfare, administration fees, insurance, books, standard college materials, and personal spending monies.
